## 2015 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon

## Sportfisher Vineyard \| Columbia Valley

## Growing Season

- The 2015 vintage was one of the warmest growing seasons on record in Washington.
- Warm temperatures continued through the spring and summer, moderating slightly into fall and extending an early harvest.
- Overall, 2015 saw very favorable growing conditions, producing optimal ripening across varieties and yielding outstanding wines throughout the region.


## Vineyard

- Sportfisher is a small vineyard nestled in the heart of the Cold Creek district. This low-yielding vineyard is planted with a Vertical Shoot Position (VSP) trellis system on rocky, silt loam soil to provide optimal drainage and support healthy growth.
- The balance between warm daytime temperatures and cooler evenings concentrated aromatics and enhanced complexity.
- The region's low rainfall yields concentrated fruit with depth and varietal expression.


## Vinification

- Hand-picked grapes were destemmed, sorted and placed into stainless steel tanks. A twice-daily pumpover regime was used to extract color and flavors.
- The grapes were cold soaked for two days prior to fermentation to help extract color and flavor from the grape skins without extracting too much tannin.
- Lots were kept separate and placed into 50\% new French oak barrels. Aging occurred for 19 months, with blending happening just prior to bottling.
