VINTAGE NOTES

- The winter began with below average temperatures. A few light frosts in early spring slowed down bud break without compromising the grape production or final quality in any way.
- Cool summer temperatures from December on assured a slow but steady ripening of the grapes on the vine.
- These climatic conditions, with some light rainfall during April and May, slightly delayed the picking of the Cabernet Sauvignon.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Sourced from Maipo Valley estate vineyards, the parcels underwent intense hand management throughout the year to produce premium grapes.
- Individual parcels were fermented separately and pumped over regularly for soft and elegant tannin extraction.
- The wines were pressed off their skins and racked into French oak barrels for 12 months and aged in the bottle for one year prior to release.

TASTING NOTES

The 2016 Hussonet Cabernet Sauvignon is an intense garnet red in color. On the nose, aromas of dark berries, chocolate and herbs are present with notes of spice. The palate is full-bodied and smooth, with elegant tannins and a persistent finish.
