2017 Reserve Red Wine Blend Beverly Vineyard

VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2017 growing season was cooler and crop yields were significantly lower in comparison to the past two vintages.
- The cool early spring, along with ample soil moisture from winter precipitation and spring rainfall, delayed ripening and helped retain fresh fruit aromatics and acidity.
- Rainfall was minimal from mid-May to mid-August and temperatures were above average in July and August.
- Despite cold winter conditions, 2017 gave us concentrated wines with classic Washington state character.

HISTORY NOTES

- Beverly Vineyard, planted in 1994, is a low-yielding vineyard on a gently sloping hill overlooking the Columbia River at Sentinel Gap.
- The bare, sandy soils and south facing slope create the perfect terroir for crafting exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon.
- The region's low rainfall yields concentrated fruit with depth and varietal expression.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Fruit was handpicked at the peak of ripeness, destemmed, sorted and placed into small oak and stainless steel tanks to build complexity.
- A twice-daily pumpover regime was used to extract color, flavors and desired tannin structure.
- After primary fermentation finished, lots were separately placed into 23% new French oak for malolactic fermentation and 18 months of aging.

TASTING NOTES

“This complex red blend has notes of blueberry, raspberry, cocoa and earthy tones. The palate is full, rich and deeply expressive but gives way to a very smooth, refined, long lasting finish.” – Reid Klei, Winemaker
