VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2017 growing season was cooler and crop yields were significantly lower in comparison to the past two vintages.
- The lower temperatures delayed ripening and helped to retain fresh fruit aromatics and mouthwatering acidity.
- Despite cold winter conditions, 2017 gave us concentrated wines with classic Washington State character.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Walla Walla Valley AVA is located in southeastern Washington by the Oregon border and is dominated by red varieties.
- Warm summer temperatures provide a vibrant ripeness in the berries, while the cool fall temperatures allow vital acidity to create balance.
- The grapes sourced from 93% Walla Walla, 5% Yakima Valley and 2% Horse Heaven Hills showcased the unique terroir of Walla Walla Valley.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Ripe grapes were destemmed, crushed and inoculated with a variety of yeasts for maximum complexity.
- Daily pumpovers were used to extract optimal flavor and color. The pumpovers can vary by block, tank and day of fermentation.
- Aged for 21 months in 41% New French oak.
