## columbia valley 2017 XLC Dry Riesling

#### VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2017 growing season was cooler and crop yields were significantly lower in comparison to the past two vintages.
- The lower temperatures delayed ripening and helped to retain fresh fruit aromatics and mouthwatering acidity.
- Despite cold winter conditions, 2017 gave us concentrated wines with classic Washington state character.

#### VINEYARD NOTES

- Eroica XLC begins in the vineyard with proper site selection taking into consideration irrigation management, crop levels and canopy management.
- Vineyard managers work to adjust yields and manage fruit exposure to prolong ripening for added flavor development.
- Evergreen Vineyard in the Ancient Lakes AVA provided a majority of the fruit for the 2017 blend.

#### HISTORY NOTES

- Launched in 1999, Eroica is a labor of love for two of the world's great Riesling producers.
- Old World, Dr. Loosen estate of Germany, and the other from the New World, Chateau Ste. Michelle of Washington state.
- An intermingling of Old and New World philosophies enables the crafting an of extraordinary Riesling from Washington state grapes.

#### WINEMAKING NOTES

- Grapes were harvested at night when the vineyard temperatures were coldest to preserve the fresh acidity.
- Berries went direct to press, avoiding the possible loss of freshness caused by a crusher/ destemmer.
- Eroica XLC was crafted in an upright oak cask with native yeast fermentation and aged for 22 months on full lees (the spent yeast).

#### TASTING NOTES

"Supple texture, remarkable depth and complex flavors are the hallmarks of Eroica XLC. Extended Lees Contact (XLC) is a modern interpretation of classic, Old World, dry-style Riesling. In keeping with Germany's Grosses Gewächs "GG" designation, this is a dry wine sourced from distinctive vineyards." - David Rosenthal, Winemaker
