2017 Red Wine Blend Walla Walla Valley

VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2017 growing season was cooler and crop yields were significantly lower in comparison to the past two vintages.
- The lower temperatures delayed ripening and helped retain fresh fruit aromatics and mouthwatering acidity.
- Despite cold winter conditions, 2017 gave us concentrated wines with classic Washington state character.

VINEYARD NOTES

- 100% of the fruit for this blend was sourced from Walla Walla's best vineyards. Merlot for the blend was sourced from Anna Marie Vineyard.
- The Cabernet Sauvignon comes from Loess and a splash of Cabernet Franc was added from Minnick Hills.
- The blended fruit provides concentrated flavors, structure, and complexity.

RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- Lamb, beef, and duck.

TASTING NOTES

Velvety, lush, and elegant, this limited production red wine from Walla Walla showcases notes of graham cracker, cherry, raspberry, vanilla, clove, and cinnamon, leading into a long and satisfying mild toasted finish.
