ADDITIONAL NOTES

VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2017 growing season was cooler and crop yields were significantly lower in comparison to the past two vintages.
- The lower temperatures delayed ripening and helped to retain fresh fruit aromatics and mouthwatering acidity.
- Despite cold winter conditions, 2017 gave us concentrated wines with classic Washington state character.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- The valley is a cooler region, which provides bright and fresh styles of Syrah.
- Often these wines see co-fermentation with Viognier to add even more fresh characters, but not in 2017.
- We chose neutral oak to balance the delicacy and freshness of the wine.

TASTING NOTES

This wine has fresh raspberry, black pepper, and a lighter tannin presence.

BLEND: 100% Syrah
