VINTAGE NOTES

- 2018 was another stellar growing season and vintage in Washington.
- Warm spring temperatures were followed by mild conditions throughout the growing season allowing for extended hang time and flavor development.
- Warm fall days allowed for full ripeness and color, while cool Washington nights helped maintain crisp natural acidity.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Planted in 1973, Cold Creek Vineyard is one of Washington's oldest and most acclaimed vineyards.
- Cold Creek Vineyard enjoys one of the longest and warmest growing seasons in the Columbia Valley.
- Cold Creek Vineyard is LIVE and Salmon Safe certified.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Riesling grapes were picked over a four week period resulting in varying sweetness levels, providing the winemaker with blending options.
- A cool fermentation was used to preserve Riesling's fresh and fruity varietal character.

RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- crab, fresh fruit, poultry, mild cheeses and Asian dishes

TASTING NOTES

"Our Cold Creek Riesling is made from 45-year-old vines which contribute fruit intensity and concentration. This is a ripe, lush style of Riesling with aromas of ripe peaches, dried apricots and spice notes. It displays beautiful ripe fruit flavors with a crisp finish." - Bob Bertheau, Winemaker
