VINTAGE NOTES

- 2018 was a stellar growing season and vintage in Washington State.
- Warm spring temperatures were followed by mild conditions throughout the growing season allowing for extended hang time and flavor development.
- Warm fall days allowed for full ripeness and color, while cool nights helped maintain crisp natural acidity.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Encompassing more than a third of the state, the Columbia Valley is Washington's largest growing region.
- The grapes were sourced from sub-appellations within the Columbia Valley.
- 62% Horse Heaven Hills, 21% Wahluke Slope and 17% from our own Cold Creek Vineyard.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Gentle pumpovers were used to extract optimal flavor and color and minimize harsh tanning
- Each individual fermentation tank was tasted daily to evaluate the development and structure of the tannins.
- Aged for 18 months in French and American oak barrels, 4% new.

TASTING NOTES

The beautiful characteristics of this Grenache are created in the vineyard through cluster-shaping techniques to ensure full ripening, then brought to life in the winery through extended macerations. Notes of strawberry and raspberry open on the nose, leading to a rich mid-palate and extended finish. — Holly Wells, Winemaker
