VINTAGE NOTES

- Timing of bud break and bloom were more consistent with long term averages; a rapid change to warmer than normal conditions quickly pushed the growing season 7-10 days ahead .
- The excessive heat and dryness stressed the vines to a point to where they slowed their metabolism to conserve water, effectively negating that early season 7-10 day head start.
- Fortunately, September cooled down to below average temperatures and with a few light precipitation events the vines returned to a state of incredible balance.

HISTORY NOTES

- ‘Ripe, round and approachable’ was our mantra as we set out selecting vineyard sites for Resplendent™ Pinot Noir.
- Distinctly rich, Resplendent™ Pinot Noir offers sumptuous tones of dark berry flavors underlain with spicy wood notes.

TASTING NOTES

This ruby beauty offers beguiling aromas of raspberry jam, strawberries, cherry turnover with vanilla icing and a fragrant hint of orange blossom. The palate is round and gratifying with flavors of plum, loganberry, pomegranate and a dash of sage. Pretty, fruit-forward and perfectly delicious.
