ADDITIONAL NOTES

The Pundit expresses finesse and balance, uniting a traditional Rhône style with all the attitude of the great Columbia Valley wines. You'll never look at Syrah the same way again.

VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2018 Vintage was warm and dry with a long growing season.
- It was in many ways a perfect Washington vintage. The resulting wines have remarkable intensity and depth.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Aged for 13 months both in barrels, and in 500 and 600L puncheons; 18% in new French oak and 7% New American Oak.
- 25% of the lots were fermented with whole clusters, with the remaining lots fermented as de-stemmed grapes.
- Majority of the young wine was placed in neutral French and American oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

The wine is deep ruby in color with garnet highlights. Aromas of blackberry and currants mingle with dark earthy undertones along with bramble and tobacco. A decadent mouthfeel with flavors of cherry, blueberry, and dark chocolate is complimented by a long, juicy, complex finish.
