2019 IMPETUS Red Wine

VINTAGE NOTES

- Winter temperatures were average preceding the 2019 growing season resulting in normal bud break occurrence.
- The abundance of snow in February provided ample soil moisture. Warm spring temperatures created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development.
- Summertime temperatures were mild with very few periods of excessive heat, followed by cooler fall temperatures which were ideal for maintaining acidity.

VINEYARD NOTES

- A majority of the grapes sourced for this red blend came from Washington's Columbia Valley (73%).
- The remaining fruit was sourced from Rattlesnake Hills (14%) and Horse Heaven Hills (13%) AVA.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Fermented in small lots for maximum flexibility during blending.
- Daily gentle pumpovers during fermentation help extract optimal flavor and color.
- Aged for 21 months in 63% new French oak and 4% new American oak.

TASTING NOTES

Building on our legacy as Washington's state's founding winery, we bring you Impetus, a visionary wine showcasing three varieties that are stellar in our growing region. This unique combination provides a mélange of structure, fruit and complexity that represents the pinnacle of excellence in Washington state winemaking.
