2019 Indian Wells Cabernet Sauvignon

VINTAGE NOTES

- Winter temperatures were average preceding the 2019 growing season resulting in little to no vine damage and bud break occurred normally.
- Warm spring temperatures created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development.
- Summertime temperatures were mild followed by cooler fall temperatures which were ideal for maintaining acidity and developing beautiful fruit flavors and aromas.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Nearly half of the fruit (46%) was sourced from our Cold Creek Vineyard, one of Washington's oldest and warmest sites.
- 16% of the fruit was sourced from Wahluke Slope, a region known for rich, ripe reds. 15% of the fruit came from Horse Heaven Hills vineyards.
- Fruit from Red Mountain, Snipes Mountain and Yakima Valley also contributed to the blend.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Cabernet Sauvignon grapes were harvested for pure fruit character and expression.
- Gentle pumpovers were used to extract optimal flavor and color and minimize harsh tannins.
- Aged for 19 months in 25% new American, 14% new French oak barrels and 61% neutral American and French oak.

TASTING NOTES

"The Indian Wells Cabernet is our warm climate ripe, jammy 'New World' style of Cabernet Sauvignon. The wine offers dark fruit aromas and flavors. Syrah added an enhanced richness and concentration to the wine."- Brian Mackey, Winemaker
