VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2019 vintage was another stellar growing season in Washington.
- Warm spring temperatures were followed by mild conditions throughout the season allowing for extended hang time and flavor development.
- Warm fall days allowed for full ripeness and color, while cool Washington nights helped maintain crisp natural acidity.

VINEYARD NOTES

- This limited production 100% Walla Walla Rosé wine was sourced from vineyards farmed specifically for making Northstar Rosé.
- Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon were sourced from Northstar Estate vineyard. Cabernet Franc was sourced from Eritage vineyard.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Grapes were harvested at early maturity for pure fruit character, brightness, and expression.
- The fruit was on the skins for a short time allowing the grapes to extract just the right amount of color creating delicate, bright flavors.
- The wine was fermented in a concrete egg to enhance aromatics and flavor.

RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- Pasta, seafood, salads, and grilled vegetables.

TASTING NOTES

Jewel-tone hues of rose gold coral. Elegant and refreshing opening with mango, white peach, and cantaloupe. Lush with notes of guava and jasmine and a hint of marzipan on the finish. As a famous chef once said, “Rosé wine goes with everything.” Enjoy with your favorite dish.
