ADDITIONAL NOTES

A partnership between Marchesi Antinori of Tuscany and Chateau Ste. Michelle of Washington, Col Solare's mission is to unite the unique winemaking cultures of these two esteemed regions to produce a world-class Syrah from the best fruit in Washington.

VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2019 growing season was cooler and crop yields were significantly lower in comparison to the past two vintages.
- The lower temperatures delayed ripening and helped retain fresh fruit aromatics and mouthwatering acidity.
- Despite cold winter conditions, 2019 gave us concentrated wines with classic Washington state character.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Harvest began on September 27 with rich flavors. After sorting, grapes were gently crushed then fermented on the skins, on average 15 days.
- Small bin and barrel fermentation was used with punch down style maceration techniques to extract the best flavors without harsh tannins.
- The wine was removed from the skins and placed into new French oak barrels for malolactic fermentation and aging.
