ADDITIONAL NOTES

The names given to Spring Valley Vineyard wines are a tribute to the family members who once owned the land where the vineyard and winery now flourish. This Cabernet Franc is named in honor of Uriah Corkrum's wife Katherine, a native of Wales who immigrated to Walla Walla Territory in 1897.

VINTAGE NOTES

- Spring was relatively wet and mild. Summer was cooler than normal with only a couple days of triple digit temperatures.
- Signs of a cool harvest early in the growing season led us to reduce the crop by green harvesting.
- Harvest began in early September and finished on October 8th.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard lies twelve miles northeast of Walla Walla, amid the picturesque wheat fields of southeastern Washington.
- The vines follow the north-south slope of the hills in vertical rows that take advantage of air flow, drainage and sunshine.
- Every grape cluster is tended by hand, including crop thinning, leaf pulling and harvesting.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard fruit is hand-picked, hand-sorted and gently de-stemmed by gravity from the "Steep Hill" and "Cap Vineyards".
- During the 10-20 day fermentation, each tank is tasted daily until the winemaker decides it is time to press using wooden cage basket presses.
- The wine is transferred into barrels for secondary fermentation and is racked several times

TASTING NOTES

"The 2019 Katherine Cabernet Franc offers aromas of dark fruit mixed with herbal, dusty and almond notes. The wine shines with a bright and splendid natural acidity and a generous mouthfeel." – Serge Laville, Winemaker
