



WALLA WALLA VALLEY 2019 Uriah Red Wine

VINTAGE NOTES

- Spring was relatively wet and mild. Summer was cooler than normal with only 2 days above 3-digit temperatures.
- Favorable conditions led to good flavor development and relatively low brix in the fruit.
- We picked our first block on September 6th with Syrah and finished on October 23rd with Petit Verdot.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard lies 12 miles northeast of Walla Walla, amid the picturesque wheat fields of southeastern Washington.
- The vines follow the north-south slope of the hills in vertical rows that allow the vines to take advantage of air drainage and sunshine.
- Every grape is tended by hand, including crop thinning, leaf pulling, and harvesting.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard fruit is hand-picked, hand-sorted and gently de-stemmed by gravity.
- In keeping with Spring Valley tradition, hand punch-downs occur twice a day until the end of alcoholic fermentation.
- The wine is transferred into barrels for secondary fermentation. Aged 30 months in French oak, stainless steel and neutral 500 Liter puncheon.

RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- Pair with meat based dishes.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Uriah Red Wine is packed with purity and rusticity. Aromas of black cherry intertwine with roasted coffee beans, herbs and a hint of minerality. On the palate, the black fruit is followed by delicate oak, herbal and floral sensations.
