2020 Guado al Tasso Scalabrone Rosé

VINTAGE NOTES

- The season started with mild weather and light rainfall. An unexpected frost in March caused slightly lower yields. Quality was not compromised as the buds were still closed.
- In April, temperatures rose and spring proceeded normally encouraging excellent flowering and fruit set that took place between the end of May and beginning of June.
- Summer was hot and dry. September had higher-than-average temperatures up until the final week when the weather turned cool and rainy; such conditions persisted until October.
- Harvest began on August 19th with Merlot, continued with Syrah and was completed by September 10th with Cabernet Sauvignon and the other complementary red grape varieties.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Guado al Tasso, literally meaning “Badger’s Ford,” takes its name from a common sight at the Tenuta Guado al Tasso estate in Bolgheri.

HISTORY NOTES

- Scalabrone is named after a local Robin Hood-like figure who lived in Bolgheri in the early 19th century.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- The three grape varieties – Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah – were picked and fermented separately.
- Maceration took place at low temperatures for 3-5 hours to obtain rich aromatics and intensity in color.
- After settling, the must was racked and began cool fermentation. The wine was kept in stainless steel tanks at low temperatures before bottling.

RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- Serve with fresh fruit - strawberries, peaches and berries. Also pairs well with fruitcakes, cookies and sweet biscuits.

TASTING NOTES

Scalabrone 2020 is a light peony pink in color. Its nose offers intense notes of red berries, in particular cherries and pomegranate, accompanied by floral sensations of rose petals and blossoms. The palate is pleasantly fruity, delicate, with excellent freshness and persistence.
