# 2020 Limited Release Block 9 Cabernet Sauvignon

## VINTAGE NOTES

- Slightly warmer than average winter temperatures proceeding the 2020 growing season resulted in little to no vine damage with normal bud break.
- Warm spring temperatures created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development.
- A mild summer with very few periods of excessive heat and cooler fall temperatures created ideal conditions for developing beautiful fruit flavors and aromas.

## VINEYARD NOTES

- 50% of the grapes were sourced from Indian Wells Vineyard in the Wahluke Slope AVA.
- 23% of the grapes were sourced from Coyote Canyon Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills AVA.
- 27% of the grapes were sourced from Elephant Mountain Vineyard in the Rattlesnake Hills AVA.

## WINEMAKING NOTES

- Grapes were destemmed and sorted with a cutting-edge grape receiving and separation system designed to gently deliver fruit to the fermenters.
- Gentle pumpovers were used to extract optimal flavor and color and minimize harsh tannins.
- Aged for 18 months in 50% new French and 4% new American oak barrels.
