VINTAGE NOTES

- Slightly warmer than average winter temperatures proceeding the 2020 growing season resulted in little to no vine damage with normal bud break.
- Warm spring temperatures created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development.
- A mild summer with very few periods of excessive heat and cooler fall temperatures created ideal conditions for developing beautiful fruit flavors and aromas.

VINEYARD NOTES

- 96% of the fruit was sourced from Stone Tree Vineyard in the Wahluke Slope AVA.
- The Wahluke Slope is a warm region known for ripe, jammy reds and complex Rhone based varietals.
- The remaining 4% of fruit was sourced from our Cold Creek Estate Vineyard to round out this wine.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Gentle pumpovers were used to extract optimal flavor and color and minimize harsh tannins.
- Each fermentation tank is tasted daily to evaluate the development of the tannins and structure.
- Aged for 18 months in 47% new French oak.

TASTING NOTES

Do you know Tempranillo? It caters to flamboyant tastes and eccentric personalities. This bold wine from Stone Tree Vineyard has the classic varietal character of dark cherries and blackberries dancing with cedar and tobacco leaf. This is a wine to share preferably over tapas and charcuterie. Salud! - Matthew Groce, Winemaker
