VINTAGE NOTES

- Slightly warmer than average winter temperatures proceeding the 2020 growing season resulted in little to no vine damage with normal bud break.
- Warm spring temperatures created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development.
- A mild summer with very few periods of excessive heat and cooler fall temperatures created ideal conditions for developing beautiful fruit flavors and aromas.

VINEYARD NOTES

- 90% of the fruit was sourced from our Cold Creek Vineyard. Planted in 1973, the south-facing site is a warm and dry with high heat accumulation.
- Cold Creek vineyard is LIVE and Salmon Safe certified.
- 10% of the grapes were sourced from Heart of the Hill Vineyard. Red Mountain is a premier site known for producing powerful, opulent wines.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Grapes were de-stemmed and sorted with a cutting-edge grape receiving and sorting system designed to gently remove any stems or leaves.
- Daily gentle pumpovers were used to extract optimal flavor and color and minimize harsh tannins.
- Aged 18 months in 40% new French oak, and 60% Neutral oak.

TASTING NOTES

Only at Chateau Ste. Michelle will you find a Cabernet like this. This is the wine every powerhouse Cabernet lover has been waiting for. Our very own Cold Creek Vineyard and Heart of the Hill Vineyard meld and rumble to form a complex and cohesive statement of decadence, balance, and depth. – Brian Mackey, Winemaker
