## VINTAGE NOTES

- Slightly warmer than average winter temperatures proceeding the 2020 growing season resulted in little to no vine damage with normal bud break.
- Warm spring temperatures created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development.
- A mild summer with very few periods of excessive heat and cooler fall temperatures created ideal conditions for developing beautiful fruit flavors and aromas.


## VINEYARD NOTES

- Sourced from Cabernet Sauvignon fruit from vineyards in the Horse Heaven Hills AVA.
- The Horse Heaven Hills AVA is home to one quarter of Washington's planted acres.
- Many vineyards in the Horse Heaven Hills are planted on south-facing slopes, providing extended sun exposure, allowing for optimal conditions.


## HISTORY NOTES

- Established in 1934, Chateau Ste. Michelle pioneered vinifera grape growing in Washington state.
- The winery owns 3,500 acres in the Columbia Valley of eastern Washington, including Horse Heaven, Canoe Ridge Estate and Cold Creek vineyards.
- Chateau Ste. Michelle's award-winning wines can be found in all 50 states and more than 100 countries worldwide.


## WINEMAKING NOTES

- Ripe grapes were destemmed and sorted with a cutting-edge grape receiving and separation system designed to gently deliver fruit to fermenters.
- Each individual fermentation tank is tasted daily to evaluate the development of the tannins and structure of the wine.
- Aged 18 months in $36 \%$ new American oak, $10 \%$ new French oak and $54 \%$ neutral oak barrels.


## RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- Braised or grilled beef, lamb chops, duck breast, and veal.
