2020 Limited Release Waussie Riesling

VINTAGE NOTES

- Slightly warmer than average winter temperatures preceding the 2020 growing season resulted in little to no vine damage with normal bud break.
- Warm spring temperatures created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development.
- A mild summer with very few periods of excessive heat and cooler fall temperatures created ideal conditions for developing beautiful fruit flavors and aromas.

VINEYARD NOTES

- A majority of the fruit came from the Lawrence Vineyard on the Royal Slope. This site lends weight and a tropical fruit character to the wine.
- Riesling fruit from Archie Den Hoed and Viewcrest Vineyards in the cooler Yakima Valley, added a back bone of crisp acidity.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Fermentation temperatures were maintained at 55-60 degrees Fahrenheit to preserve Riesling's fresh fruit character.
- The "Riesling Taste Profile" scale is on the back label of this bottle to illustrate that this particular wine is made in a dry style.

TASTING NOTES

"It's back after a five-year hiatus. Washington + Aussie is a bone dry racy style Riesling packed with mandarin orange and lemon aromas that beg for fresh seafood and summer salads. This wine, sourced from a high elevation site, will leave your mouth watering and your mind at ease."
