2020 Cabernet Sauvignon Walla Walla Valley

VINTAGE NOTES

- Slightly warmer than average winter temperatures preceding the 2020 growing season resulted in little to no vine damage with normal bud break.
- Warm spring temperatures created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development.
- A mild summer with very few periods of excessive heat and cooler fall temperatures created ideal conditions for developing beautiful fruit flavors and aromas.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Fruit was selected from the very best possible Walla Walla sources.
- Cabernet Sauvignon from our favorite vineyards in the Walla Walla Valley went into the creation of this blend.
- In 2020 the fruit was sourced from Loess and Minnick Hills.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Grapes were destemmed, crushed, and inoculated with Premier Cuvee yeast to begin the fermentation. The must was punched down daily .
- Racking occurred every three months for clarity during the 20-month aging process.
- Aged in 100% French oak – 29% of the barrels were new. This 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon was bottled unfiltered and unfiltered for maximum flavor.

TASTING NOTES

This limited production Walla Walla Cabernet Sauvignon is soft and approachable. Aromas of cherry and raspberry intertwine with sage and toffee leading into a long finish of vanilla and almond.
