VINTAGE NOTES

- 2021 was a very warm growing season which resulted in intensely concentrated flavors in the wines.
- Our typical cool nights during harvest helped us retain the wonderful natural acidity Washington is known for.
- The season produced red wines dark in color and dense in concentration and white wines with varietal character and bright vibrancy.

VINEYARD NOTES

- This Cabernet is sourced from Indian Wells Vineyard on the Wahluke Slope in Eastern Washington.
- The grapes are grown in two certified Organic vineyard blocks with extra care and minimal inputs.
- A very warm growing area, the Wahluke Slope is a large, steep hillside bordered on both the west and the south by the Columbia River.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Winemaking inputs are kept to the barest minimum to allow the grapes to fully express their site and growing conditions.
- Daily gentle pumpovers during fermentation help extract optimal flavor and color.
- Each fermentation lot is tasted daily to evaluate the evolution of the tannins in order to find the right moment to drain the wine off skins.
