VINTAGE NOTES

- 2021 was a very warm growing season which resulted in intensely concentrated flavors in the wines.
- Our typical cool nights during harvest helped us retain the wonderful natural acidity Washington is known for.
- The season produced red wines dark in color and dense in concentration and white wines with varietal character and bright vibrancy.

VINEYARD NOTES

- 98% of the fruit was sourced from Stone Tree Vineyard in the Wahluke Slope AVA.
- The Wahluke Slope is a warm region known for ripe, jammy reds and complex Rhone based varietals.
- The remaining 2% of fruit was sourced from our Canoe Ridge Estate Vineyard to round out this wine.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Gentle pumpovers were used to extract optimal flavor and color and minimize harsh tannins.
- The bold Tempranillo was blended with Grenache, as is traditionally done in Spain to temper and round out the wine.
- Aged for 22 months in 16% new French oak, 64% neutral French oak, and 20% neutral American oak.

TASTING NOTES

A drink for the daring. This audacious wine is not shy about the layers of marionberry, dark cherry and sweet tobacco that dance across your tongue. Best enjoyed with live music and dancing under the starlight. To the iconoclast grape of Washington, salud! - Matthew Groce, Winemaker
