## 2021 Sauvignon Blanc

### VINTAGE NOTES

- 2021 was a very warm growing season which resulted in intensely concentrated flavors in the wines.
- Our typical cool nights during harvest helped us retain the wonderful natural acidity Washington is known for.
- The season produced red wines dark in color and dense in concentration and white wines with varietal character and bright vibrancy.

### VINEYARD NOTES

- Sauvignon Blanc fruit ripen very quickly with harvest happening between mid-August and early September.
- Some blocks spend up to three extra weeks on the vine to showcase riper melon flavors alongside the traditional tropical fruit flavors.
- Numerous vineyard sites in the Horse Heaven Hills have a noticeable wet stone finish that we always try to use as a blending tool.

### WINEMAKING NOTES

- Per 5 fl. Oz. Calories: 105 per serving Carbs (g): 3.4 Protein (g): 0 Sugar (g): Less than 1 g per 5oz glass Fat (g): 0
- The blend is 100% Sauvignon Blanc with specific tanks being selected to show the amazing fruit and wet stone finish.
- To build a little mouthfeel and texture to the wine, 18% of the blend was fermented and aged for one month in oak ovals.

### RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- Fish tacos, Greek salad, and fresh fruit tart

This Sauvignon Blanc has the freshness of juicy pineapple green apple, and white peach flavors all complimented by the Horse Heaven Hills signature finish of smooth minerality.
