VINTAGE NOTES

- 2021 was a very warm growing season which resulted in intensely concentrated flavors in the wines.
- Our typical cool nights during harvest helped us retain the wonderful natural acidity Washington is known for.
- The season produced red wines dark in color and dense in concentration and white wines with varietal character and bright vibrancy.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Stone Tree Vineyard provided a majority of the fruit for this blend, 55% Petit Verdot and 12% Merlot.
- The remaining 33% of Petit Verdot was sourced from Shaw Red Mountain.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Grapes were de-stemmed and crushed leaving 40% whole berries, and inoculated with Premier Cuvee yeast and remained on skins for 5 days.
- It was racked into barrels to undergo malolactic fermentation, during which racking occurred every three months for clarity.
- Aged 16 months 56% French oak and 44% American oak of which 50% were new barrels.

RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- Hearty dishes, aged cheese, lamb chops, and roasted pork

This limited production bold savory Petit Verdot opens with robust aromas and flavors of black truffle, orange zest, vanilla, and a lush blackberry, dark chocolate, and spicy floral finish. - David "Merf" Merfeld, Winemaker
