## 2022 Rosé of Cabernet Franc

VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2022 season started with an unusually cool and wet spring. Below average temperatures from April to July caused delay in ripening, causing a late harvest.
- All of the moisture in the ground helped develop beautiful canopies with a nice size crop.
- The quality of fruit was outstanding, producing very promising wines that show nice acidity and beautiful flavors.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard lies 12 miles northeast of Walla Walla, amid the picturesque wheat fields of southeastern Washington.
- The vines follow the north-south slope of the hills in vertical rows that allow the vines to take advantage of air drainage and sunshine.
- Every grape is tended by hand, including crop thinning, leaf pulling, and harvesting.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- The 2022 Rosé is made of 100% Cabernet Franc from our Estate Vineyard.
- The fruit was handpicked in late-September and pressed right away, creating a gorgeous blush color.
- It was aged in a combination of stainless steel and acacia barrels. The wine was bottled early Spring 2022.

RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

- Great for summer BBQ dishes, pizza, roasted vegetables, prosciutto and melon, salads.

TASTING NOTES

This Rosé of Cabernet Franc reveals beautiful aromas of citrus and orange blossom. On the palate, the wine is creamy and dry, with subtle notes of lemon cake. The finish is soft and savory, with subtle hints of minerality. - Kate Derby, winemaker
