2022 Uriah Red Wine

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Uriah Franklin Corkrum settled in Spring Valley 100 years ago to farm wheat and raise a family. The unique terroir of this beautiful valley provides a superior red wine grape, which we blend for our Estate grown “Uriah”.

VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2022 season started with an unusually cool and wet spring. Below average temperatures from April to July caused delay in ripening, causing a late harvest.
- All of the moisture in the ground helped develop beautiful canopies with a nice size crop.
- The quality of fruit was outstanding, producing very promising wines that show nice acidity and beautiful flavors.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard lies 12 miles northeast of Walla Walla, amid the picturesque wheat fields of southeastern Washington.
- The vines follow the north-south slope of the hills in vertical rows that allow the vines to take advantage of air drainage and sunshine.
- Every grape is tended by hand, including crop thinning, leaf pulling, and harvesting.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard fruit is hand-picked, hand-sorted and gently de-stemmed by gravity from the “Steep Hill” and “Cap Vineyards”.
- During the 10-20 day fermentation, each tank is tasted daily until the winemaker decides it is time to press using wooden cage basket presses.
- The wine is transferred into barrels for secondary fermentation and is racked several times. Aged for 19 months in 100% French oak.

TASTING NOTES

The 2022 Uriah is terroir driven with aromas of wheat, black currant, a glimpse of plum fig and cigar box. On the palate, the blackberry and raspberry fruit is followed by smooth tannins and a soft rose petal mid palate. The wine finishes with great texture, smooth tannins and a mouthwatering finish.– Kate Derby, Winemaker
