VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2023 vintage started with a cool spring, followed by ideal conditions during the summer with warm days and cool nights perfect for grape maturity and flavor development.
- Lower yields, uniform canopies and even ripening contributed to exceptional quality.
- Harvest began earlier than usual with grapes showing excellent ripe flavor profiles, natural acidity, and nice tannins.
- Winemakers indicate the 2023 vintage in Washington is set to become one of the best in a long time.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Fruit was sourced from a unique block in the Horse Heaven Hills
- The region's latitude provides an extra hour of sunlight (and heat) during the peak of the growing season creating intense fruit flavors.
- Columbia Valley receives only 1/3 (6" to 10") the annual rainfall vines need requiring drip irrigation which leads to more flavorful grapes.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Cabernet Sauvignon grapes were picked with relatively low sugar and good acidity.
- The fruit was pressed gently, producing juice with very little color.
- An extended, cool fermentation in a stainless-steel tank maintained bright aromatics and fresh flavors.

RECOMMENDED FOOD PAIRINGS

• Poached salmon, pan-seared scallops, or grilled veggie skewers

TASTING NOTES

This intricate White Cabernet Sauvignon reveals aromas of strawberries, raspberries, and watermelon. The wine is lively and bright with flavors of fresh stone fruit and red berries.
