2023 Uriah Red Wine

VINTAGE NOTES

- The 2023 season started with a cool spring, followed by ideal conditions during the summer with warm days and cool nights perfect for grape maturity and flavor development.
- Lower yields, uniform canopies, and even ripening contributed to exceptional quality.
- Harvest began earlier than usual with grapes showing excellent ripe flavor profiles, natural acidity, and nice tannins.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard lies 12 miles northeast of Walla Walla, amid the picturesque wheat fields of southeastern Washington.
- The vines follow the north-south slope of the hills in vertical rows that allow the vines to take advantage of air drainage and sunshine.
- Every grape is tended by hand, including crop thinning, leafing, and harvesting.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Spring Valley Vineyard fruit is hand-picked, hand-sorted and gently de-stemmed by gravity from our estate vineyards.
- During the 10-20 day fermentation each tank is tasted daily until the winemaker decides it's time to press using a stainless steel basket press.
- The wine is transferred into barrels for secondary fermentation and is racked 2 more times. The wine spends about 19 months in 100% French oak.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of bright red and blue fruit like raspberry and blueberry and a trace of fresh cut wheat on the nose. The palate, is beautifully balanced with red fruit and smooth tannins and a velvety dusty rose pedal mid palate. The wine finishes with great texture, smooth tannins and a mouthwatering finish.— Kate Derby, Winemaker
