As the state's founding winery, Chateau Ste. Michelle combines a terroir-driven style with boutique winemaking practices to create expressive, world-class wines that reflect the distinct character of Washington's Columbia Valley.

Our Single Vineyard wines are site-specific expressions of the Columbia Valley terroir: distinct, structured, and crafted for a true sense of place.

TASTING NOTES

Sourced from one of Washington's premier Riesling vineyards, the Evergreen Vineyard Riesling is a crisp, dry wine offering vibrant notes of lime, blood orange, and delicate floral notes, with a touch of minerality.

VINEYARD / AVA

Located in the Ancient Lakes AVA, Evergreen Vineyard was planted more than a decade before the region's official recognition in 2012. Its cool climate, moderated by the Columbia River, creates long hang time, vibrant acidity, and the bright, mineral-driven style that defines Evergreen Riesling. Missoula Flood-carved soils of Quincy loam over caliche further enhance the wine's structure, freshness, and pronounced minerality.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2024 vintage experienced typical temperatures, requiring minimal canopy and crop management and allowing its natural character to shine. A long ripening season, precise harvest timing, and low disease pressure produced flavorful, well-balanced white wines.
