- The 2025 harvest was exceptional, with favorable weather holding steady throughout the season.
- Fruit development continued well into fall, supported by Washington's signature cool nights that arrived in mid-September.
- Despite the warmth of the year, our red wines retained vibrant acidity reminiscent of cooler vintages.
- The result is wines with refined, elegant tannins and remarkable balance, truly a standout vintage.

#### VINEYARD NOTES

- Nestled in the rain shadow of Washington's Cascade mountain range, lies the Columbia Valley.
- The Columbia Valley is a region where abundant sunlight, cool nights, and volcanic soils converge to create wines of remarkable complexity.

#### TASTING NOTES
